

WHAT CLASS OF ANIMAL CAN I FEED PROFELAC GOLD TO?

ProfeLAC Gold is a premium-quality calf milk replacer containing Bovatec® that assists in managing coccidiosis and improving average daily gain and feed conversion efficiency. It's an ideal all-purpose dairy calf milk replacer, especially where coccidiosis is perceived to be a risk.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQS)

WHY ISN'T A SET MIX RATE LISTED ON THE BAG?

Like our own children, calves need more food as they grow, and we should, therefore, provide more milk to support their growth and health as they get bigger. Due to the significant differences between various calf operations and facilities, there are many options for increasing intake, such as adjusting mix rate, feed volume, and the number of feeds per day to suit the system and the calf's current size.

CAN I FEED PROFELAC GOLD TO BEEF CALVES?

Yes, you can, but we recommend using a lower-spec calf milk replacer for beef calves, such as ProfeLAC Beef.

HOW DO I CALCULATE WHOLE MILK VS. MILK REPLACER'S DRY MATTER?

The best way to measure the dry matter of whole milk is with a hydrometer or brix meter, where the percentage shown is the dry matter. If you don't have those tools available, a good rule of thumb is that vat milk has about 125g of solids per litre, so each litre provides 125g of DMI (dry matter intake). It is much simpler with CMR (Calf Milk Replacer); roughly 1 gram of CMR is a gram of solids (technically, it is 1.03g of CMR to a gram of solids, but using a ratio of 1:1 works fine). Balance the milk DMI with the CMR to achieve the target intake (suggest <1.5% of body weight as DMI).
